

City Ordinance No 15<sup>th</sup> entitled

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An Ordinance relating to the grading and  
graveling of the intersections or squares of Streets.

The city of Albany does ordain as follows,

Sec 1<sup>st</sup> That the owners of lots in the quarter blocks  
adjoining the intersections or squares of  
Streets in the City of Albany upon Lyon Street  
between Water Street and Ninth Street upon Broad  
Albin Street between Water Street and Ninth Street  
upon Elsworth Street between Water Street  
and Ninth Street and upon First Street first  
between Jefferson Street and Montgomery Street  
be and they are hereby required at their own  
expense under the supervision of the city Marshal  
to grade and gravel said intersections or  
squares as hereinafter directed adjoining the  
respective quarter blocks in which their lots  
are situated

Sec 2<sup>nd</sup> That the grade of said intersections  
shall be determined by the city Marshal  
with or without the aid of a surveyor as  
said City Marshal shall deem best

Sec 3<sup>rd</sup> That said intersections or squares  
be gravelled to the depth of not less than four  
inches and to the width of twenty feet two  
feet from the center line respectively of  
Lyon Street Broad Albin Street Elsworth  
Street and First Street

Sec 4 That the grading and graveling of the  
intersections or squares of streets mentioned  
in Sec 1<sup>st</sup> of this ordinance shall be com-  
pleted on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of  
October 1871

Sec 5 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and  
after five days from the date of its passage
