

Ordinance No. 69

Relating to the purchase of
a number four Clapp &
James Steam Fire Engine from
Linn Engine Company Num-
ber 2, and to appropriate mon-
ey therefor.

Be it Ordained by the
Common Council of the City
of Albany.

Section I. The Committee on
Fire and Water is hereby au-
thorized and required to pur-
chase for the use of the City
of Albany, the number four
Clapp and James Steam Fire
Engine from Linn Engine
Company No 2 of the City of
Albany and to pay for said
engine the sum of \$3614.92,
Three Thousand Six hundred and
fourteen and 92/100 dollars
in Gold or Silver coin less the
sum of one thousand dollar paid
by the City for the use of the same
and less the further sum of
one hundred and twenty and
77/100 dollars now paid or here-
after to be paid and report
to the Council as soon as
possession of said engine
shall be obtained.

Section II. The City Recorder is
hereby authorized and
required on the filing of the
report of the Committee

as provided in Section One, to draw
 out Order on the Treasurer for
 the sum of Fourteen hundred
 and ninety four and 15/100 dol-
 lars in gold or Silver Coin in favor
 of the Secretary of Lima Engine
 Company No 2 and to is-
 sue a warrant or order on
 the Treasurer payable Three
 Months after date for the sum of
 one thousand dollars in Gold
 or Silver Coin in favor of the Sec-
 retary of Lima Engine Co. No 2
 provided said warrant or or-
 der shall draw no interest un-
 til it becomes due

Section III This Ordinance to be
 in force from and after five
 days after its publication
