Ordinance No. 1184

An Ordinance to regulate the using and running of unicycles, or bicycles in the City of Albany.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany.

Sec I. That all persons are hereby prohibited from riding a unicycle, Bicycle or tri-cycle upon the sidewalks on First street in the City of Albany; provided this ordinance shall not apply to any person who use such vehicle for the purpose of travel.

Sec II. That any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction before the Recorder, be fined in any sum not less than five nor more than ten dollars.

Sec III This Ordinance to be in force five days from and after its passage and publication.
