

Ordinance No. 219.

An Ordinance relating to establishing the grade, depth and location of main sewers in Maple, Perry, and Madison streets in the City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the established grade and location of a main sewer in each of the ~~respective~~ following named streets, to wit, Maple, Perry, and Madison streets in the City of Albany, be in conformity to the survey, plans and profile thereof made by Surveyor Barr in the year 1891, and filed in the Office of the City Recorder on the 28th day of July in said year. And the main sewers hereafter to be constructed in each of said streets shall be on the grade, at the depth, and in the location, designated by said survey, and the plans and profile thereof.

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Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
