

Ordinance No. 239.

An Ordinance To amend section one (1) of Ordinance Number 213, entitled "An Ordinance to establish the grade of certain streets in the City of Albany," passed April 25th 1890, Approved April 29th 1890.

The People of the City of Albany, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That section one (1) of Ordinance number 213, entitled, "An Ordinance to establish the grade of certain streets in the City of Albany" passed April 25th 1890, Approved April 29th 1890, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1: The established grade of the streets in the City of Albany, north of the Salem road and extending from Main street to the eastern boundary line of the City of Albany, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor W. B. Barr, in the year 1890, and now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, save and except that the established grade of Water Street, and of Front Street from the east line of Main Street, to the west line of Pine Street, and of Sherman Street and Oak Street, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor, W. B. Barr in the year 1891, and now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany; and except that the established grade of First Street from the east line of Main Street to the east line of Pine Street, and Oak Street and Sherman Street from the north line of Second Street to the south line of Water Street, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor, W. B. Barr in the year 1892 and filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany February 9th 1892, and adopted

and approved by resolution number 18th adopted by the Council March 31st 1892.

Section 2: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance, in so far only as they may relate to this Ordinance, in so far only as they may relate to this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
