

Ordinance no 278

*Ord 1886*  
 An Ordinance to create the office of Superintendent of Streets, to authorize the appointment of a suitable person superintendent of streets, by the Council, and to define his duties, and to repeal Ordinance no. 210, entitled "an Ordinance to create the office of Superintendent of Streets, and to define his duties; to provide for and regulate the establishment, and allocation of the grade of streets, and alleys, or any part thereof, and providing for the grading of streets and alleys, or any part thereof; and for the construction, improvement and repairing of sidewalks, pavements, streets, alleys, sewers, drains, bridges and aqueducts, within the limits of the City of Albany, when, in the judgement of the Common Council of said City, such work is necessary, and to provide for the assessment, and collection of the costs, and expenses thereof, and providing for the Recording, and enforcement of liens upon the property adjacent to such improvement," approved April 16<sup>th</sup> 1891, and to repeal Ordinance no. 227, amending section 4, of said Ordinance no. 210, approved Oct 24<sup>th</sup> 1891.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain  
 as follows:

Section 1: The Council of the City of Albany may at their option appoint a suitable person to serve as Superintendent of Streets, who shall hold his office during the pleasure of the Council, and shall receive such compensation for his services as the Council may direct.

Section 2: It shall be the duty of the said Superintendent of Streets, to superintend the grading, and grading, improving, and repairing of all streets, and alleys, and to see that the same are graded, and graded, improved, and repaired in accordance with the orders, and ordinances of the Council providing therefor.

, and to superintend the construction of all Sidewalks, Crosswalks, bridges, Culverts, and Aqueducts, and the construction of all drains, and sewers, and repairs thereof ordered by the Council, and to see that they are constructed, and repaired in accordance with the orders of the Council, and Ordinances of the City governing the construction, and repair of such Sidewalks, Crosswalks, bridges, Culverts, and Aqueducts, drains, and sewers. It shall also be the duty of the Superintendent of Streets, to clean all public squares, street crossings, and alleys, and to see that the same are kept free from all rubbish, garbage, and obstructions, to make all necessary repairs to crosswalks, and to keep such crosswalks in good, and safe condition, and to perform such other duties, as the Council may direct, and order.

Section 3: Ordinance no. 310, entitled, "An Ordinance to create the office of Superintendent of Streets, and to define his duties, to provide for, and regulate the establishment, and alteration of the grade of streets, and alleys, or any part thereof, and providing for the grading of streets, and alleys, or any part thereof, and for the construction of sewers, drains, bridges, and Aqueducts, within the limits of the City of Albany, when in the judgement of the Common Council of said City such work is necessary, and to provide for the assessment, and collection of the costs, and expenses thereof, and providing for the execution and enforcement of liens upon the property adjacent to, and abutting such improvements," approved April 16<sup>th</sup> 1874, and Ordinance no. 227, amending section 4 of said Ordinance no. 310, approved Oct 29<sup>th</sup> 1874, are hereby repealed.

Section 4: All Ordinances, or parts, of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and

be in full force, from and after, its approval by the Mayor.
