

Ord No. 333 An Ordinance Authorizing, and Enforcing,
 the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon,
 to enter into and sign written articles of agreement,
 with H. C. Harkness of Albany, Oregon, for constructing
 a "Water Pipe" line for fire purposes, on the east
 side of Perry Street, from Third street "water pipe
 line" to Second street, and on the west side of
 Ellsworth Street, from Third street "water pipe
 line" to the "fire Cistern", at intersection of First
 and Ellsworth streets.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain
as follows:

Section 1: That, the Mayor and Recorder of the City of
 Albany, Oregon be, and they are hereby authorized,
 directed, and empowered, to enter into, and sign
 written articles of agreement with H. C. Harkness,
 of Albany, Oregon, for constructing and laying ^{of}
 "water pipe" line, of Eight (8) inch Vitrified Iron pipe,
 including all material and labor necessary
 therefor, on the East side of Perry Street, from Third
 Street "water pipe" line to Second Street, and from said
 Third Street "water pipe line", on the west side of Ellsworth,
 Street, to the "fire Cistern", at the intersection of First and
 Ellsworth streets in said City, at the rate and price
 of (\$53) fifty-three cents per foot for Perry street pipe
 line, and (\$54 1/2) fifty-four and a half cents per
 foot for Ellsworth Street, "pipe line", as set forth,
 and stated in the bids of said H. C. Harkness,
 submitted to the City Council of said City August
 8th 1899, and accepted by said Council August 25th
 1899.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full
 force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
