A bill for, an ordinance, authorizing the building and laying of a wooden sidewalk six feet in width, on the south side of Front Street, abutting on the north line of the north half of lots one and two in Block No. two of Mackleman's third addition to the city of Albany, Oregon and also on the north side of Ninth Street, abutting the south line of lots seven and eight in Block No. six in the city of Albany, Oregon, and do authorize the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract on the part of the City of Albany for the construction of the same, and providing for the costs and expenses of the building and laying of said sidewalk to be assessed to the holders and owners of lots and parts of lots abutting and adjoining said sidewalk.

The people of the City of Albany - do Ordain - as follows:

Section 1: - That there be constructed on the south side of Front Street, abutting the north line of the north half of lots one and two in Block No. two of Mackleman's Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon and also on the north side of Ninth Street, abutting the south line of lots seven and eight in Block No. six in the City of Albany, Oregon, a wooden sidewalk six feet in width in front of and adjacent to said lots on the south side and north side thereof, and that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be, and are hereby authorized said directed and empowered to enter into and sign on the part of the City of Albany, written articles of agreement for the construction and laying of a sidewalk six feet in width along the south side of Front Street, abutting the north line of the north half of lots one and two in

Block 70^{3rd} to top of trackman's addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, also on the North side of 7th street extending on the South side of 8th street, and eight on Block 70 partly two in the City of Albany Oregon. That the cost of the construction and laying and building of said sidewalk be assessed to the several owners of the lots to which it abutting on and adjacent to said sidewalk when constructed; provided that such owners shall not be entered into and such articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of the City until after the proposals for the construction of said sidewalk has been advertised for in the manner provided for by the City Charter and ordinances regulating and awarding all contracts and bids have been received and considered by the Council and the contract awarded by the Council and the cost and extent for constructing said sidewalk fixed and determined.

Section 2:— This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
