A bill for an ordinance to prohibit the giving or selling of intoxicating liquors to common drunkards, to provide a punishment therefor and to define what shall constitute, and who are common drunkards.

The Public Health of Albany, Oregon is hereby declared to be as follows:

Section I - That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to sell, give, or in any manner dispose of any fermented liquors, brandy, or wine, or any fermented or malt liquors to any common drunkard within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon County, Oregon.

Section II - That any person or persons who are in the habit of frequently becoming intoxicated, and who have a habit of using intoxicating liquors to an excess shall be deemed to be a common drunkard within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section III - Whenever it shall satisfactorily appear to the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, that any person or persons within the corporate limits of said city is in the habit of frequently becoming intoxicated, and a habit of using intoxicating liquors to an excess, it may, by resolution, declare said person or persons to be a common drunkard, and said person or persons shall thereafter be deemed to be a common drunkard within the meaning of this ordinance until disreputation is thereafter repealed.

Section IV - That any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this

ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a
 misdemeanor, and upon conviction
 thereof, before the Recorder's Court, be
 punished by a fine of not less than
 \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00, or by
 imprisonment in the City Jail for
 not less than five days nor more
 than fifty days, or by both said fine
 and imprisonment, at the discretion
 of the Court for such offence.

Section I - This ordinance shall be
 in full force and effect from and after its
 approval by the Mayor
