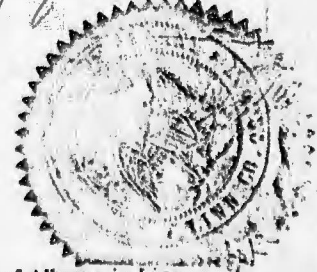
An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor & Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with the O'Brien Coffee Company to increase the fire fuel in the city and to appropriate funds in payment therefor.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:
Section I. That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into a contract with the O'Brien Coffee Company to increase and have fuel in the city for the use and benefit of the City and to purchase fire alarm apparatus, and to pay therefor not to exceed the sum of \$13,190.00 lawful money of the United States which payment may be made in cash within sixty days after the date of the invoice shall be received by the City, or at the option of the City of Albany the same may be paid in two warrants for the sum of \$500.00 payable on or before December 1st 1903, and one warrant for \$12,690.00 payable on or before December 1st 1904, said warrants to bear interest at the rate of 6% per annum until paid.

Section II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after approval by the Mayor.
