

## ORDINANCE NO. 399.

An Ordinance declaring an assessment and to fix and establish a lien for sidewalk improvements on the South East quarter of Block No. 129, in Hart Lemans Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, for the construction of a sidewalk on the West side of Main Street and adjacent to the above described property.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That whereas on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1904, a resolution was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, declaring the intention of the said City to improve Main Street in said City by building a sidewalk on the West side thereof and adjacent to the following described premises to-wit:-

The South East quarter of Block No. 129, in Hart Lemans Addition to the City of Albany, in Clatsop County, Oregon.

And whereas the said City Council caused due and legal notice thereof to be given, as required by law, and no objections or remonstrances being made to the proposed improvement or the building of said sidewalk, thereafter on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of December 1904, duly passed an ordinance ordering the construction of the said sidewalk at the cost and expense of the owners of the adjacent property and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of said City to enter into and sign on the part of the City of Albany written articles of agreement for the construction of said sidewalk, after proposals for the construction thereof had been advertised for in the manner provided for in the City Charter, and the ordinances regulating the awarding of all contracts, and bids had been received and considered by the said Council and the contract awarded by the Council, and the costs and expenses of constructing the same had been ascertained, fixed and determined; and whereas the said contract for the construction of the said sidewalk was thereafter duly made and entered into by the Mayor and Recorder on behalf of the City of Albany, and the Superintendent of Streets of the said City, having charge of said work for the said City of Albany having duly reported that the said work has been completed according to contract, and that the costs of advertising and the construction of said work and other costs connected therewith, amounted to the sum of \$28<sup>64</sup>.

Section 2. That there be and there is thereby assessed upon the said real property above described, the sum of \$28<sup>64</sup> and that said amount shall be a lien upon said property above described, until the full payment thereof, and that

a record of said lien be entered upon the lien docket of the said city of Albany, and that the Recorder be and he is hereby directed to give notice to M. J. Sillerton the owner of said property, of the assessment of said costs upon said property above described for the improvements so made, and if said sum is not paid within ten days after the giving and service of said notice, that the Recorder of said city issue a warrant for the collection of said sum, directed to the City Marshal to forthwith levy upon and sell the hereinabove described property as provided by law.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor. Approved this 15th day of March 1905
