Ord. No. 421

Relating to Police Force

An ordinance requiring the City Marshal to perform police duty during the night time, and appointing G. M. Payne and C. O. Lee policemen, and prescribing their duties.

The People of Albany do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That the Marshal of the City of Albany is hereby required to perform police duty in said city during the night time.

Sec. 2. That G. M. Payne and C. O. Lee are hereby appointed policemen of the City of Albany, with the usual powers, but without other compensation than that now received by them as Superintendent of Streets and City Engineer respectively; and they are hereby required to perform police duty in said city during the day time.

Sec. 3. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
