

ORDINANCE No. 429

Trucks, Drays Standing on certain Streets

That Ordinance prohibiting the driver or owner of any licensed Truck, Dray, wagon or other vehicle used for the transportation of freight from standing such vehicle in front of any business house located on First or Second Streets between Lyon and Washington Streets and upon Eleventh, Broadalbin or Ferry Streets between First and Second Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon except when receiving or discharging freight.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:  
Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for a driver or owner or manager of any Truck, Dray, wagon or other vehicle licensed by the City of Albany and used for the transportation of goods, merchandise, fuel, lumber or freight of any kind to make a stand or other vehicle in front of any business house located on First or Second Streets, between Lyon and Washington Streets, or on Eleventh, Broadalbin or Ferry Streets, between First and Second Streets, in the City of Albany, Oregon or stop and make a stand or resort on said Streets, except when receiving or discharging freight.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder Court be fined in the sum of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$20.00 or imprisoned in the City Jail not less than 2 nor more than 10 days.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after 30 days after its approval by the Mayor.
