An Ordinance granting P. W. Spink permission to erect a lumber yard structure on lots three and four in block three in the City of Albany

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows

Section 1. That P. W. Spink be and he is by this ordinance granted the right and permission to erect a shed to be known as a lumber yard structure on lots three and four in block three in the City of Albany, Oregon, covering the whole of said lots.

Said structure to consist of a brick office sixteen by twenty feet to be built on the southeast corner of said lot four in said block, and the remainder of said lots shall be covered with a roof of corrugated iron placed on wooden poles or posts of a good and substantial kind, and firmly set on concrete or brick piers and of sufficient height for the convenient handling of lumber. Such structure for the support of said roof shall be built in a good and substantial manner, and in accordance with the plat therefor attached to the petition of said P. W. Spink for the permission hereby granted him to erect such structure, which said petition and plat are on file in the Recorder's Office of said City of Albany. Said structure to be built and covered with corrugated iron to have no side walls.

Section 2. In so much as the immediate erection of the said lumber yard structure, and office on said lots, and the speedy removal of all the old buildings now thereon will greatly lessen the liability and danger of building in the vicinity of said lots so far as exposure to fire is concerned, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
