A Bill for

An Ordinance regulating the riding and driving of Automobiles and other vehicles propelled by Gasoline, Electric or Steam power, over and on the Streets of the City of Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That it shall be unlawful to ride or drive or cause any automobile, or other vehicle, propelled by gasoline, electric or steam power, to go at a greater rate of speed over, or upon, or along the streets of the City of Albany, at a greater rate of speed than eight miles per hour.

Section 2: That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to ride or drive, or cause any automobile or other vehicle propelled by gasoline, electric or steam power, to be run over, or on any bridge on the public streets within the City of Albany at a greater rate of speed than four (4) miles per hour.

Section 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars, nor more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail, not less than two (2) days, nor more than fifty (50) days.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after thirty days from its approval by the Mayor.
