

ORDINANCE No. 461

Contract for paving Ferry Street

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with the Warren Construction Company for the improvement of Ferry Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street in said City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Whereas, by Ordinance No 453 of the City of Albany, passed by the Council on the 11th day of August 1901 and approved by the Mayor on the 15th day of August 1901, it was ordered that the following Street of said City of Albany, to-wit:

Ferry Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street in said City of Albany, be improved as follows:-

- First. By grading the street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second. By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections, with bituminous pavement.
- Third. By constructing artificial stone curbs.
- Fourth. By constructing cement sidewalk.
- Fifth. By laying and constructing Bituminous Leaders.
- Sixth. By constructing inlets.
- Seventh. By constructing catch basins.
- Eighth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvements to be made according to the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of said City.

And whereas, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of said City give notice for bids for the making of said improvements in the manner provided by said Ordinance.

And whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the City Recorder of said City according to law and the Ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit, on the 27th day of August, 1901, the Warren Construction Company, a Corporation of Portland, Oregon, presented to the Council its bid for making said proposed improvements which bid was made in full form and in compliance with all the conditions imposed by law and by the Council, by which said bid said Warren Construction Company proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the

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the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices

Excavation per cubic yard	8.	75
Continued foundation per cubic yard	3.	00
Bitulithic surface price per square yard	2.	00
Embankment price per cubic yard	21	
Salts price per each.	12.	50
Catch basins price per each.	25.	00
Curer Ck. Lurch price per line of foot	70	
Bitulithic headers price per lineal foot	40	

And whereas said Warren Construction Company was the lowest responsible bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

Section 1. That the said bid of the said Warren Construction Company for said improvement of said above described street be and the same is hereby accepted, and the Mayor and the Recorder of said City, are hereby authorized to enter into a contract, in writing, with the said Warren Construction Company for the making of said improvement, as aforesaid, in behalf of the City, upon the terms mentioned in said bid, said contract to provide, further, that the work of said proposed improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract and to be prosecuted with such speed that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of July, 1909, and that the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of Ten Dollars per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond the date specified therein; and that the said Warren Construction Company furnish a bond in the sum of \$1000.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, having as surety some surety company, authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the Warren Construction Company, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claims or liens for labor, work or materials on the part of any person deriving out of said contract.

Section 2. Whereas the public health and safety requires that work be commenced on said proposed

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improvement at an early date, and before the winter rains
render it impossible to properly perform the same,
in emergency as hereby declared to exist, and this
ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
after its approval by the Mayor.
