

ORDINANCE No. 466

Prohibit Barbed wire fences.

An Ordinance to punish any person, firm or corporation by fine for constructing, or allowing to remain that has been constructed, any barbed wire fence within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. No barbed wire fence shall hereafter be erected, constructed, maintained or allowed to remain as part of any fence within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, and it is hereby made the duty of any person, firm or corporation now having or maintaining any barbed wire fence or any fence made partly of barbed wire, to tear down and remove such barbed wire fence, and remove all barbed wire used as part of any fence within twenty days from the date of the approval hereof; and any person, firm or corporation or the manager of any corporation violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than ten dollars, and each day's continuance of such violation shall be considered and held to be a separate and additional offense.

Section 2. In as much as there are several fences bordering the sidewalks along the streets of the City of Albany, where barbed wire is used, and thereby liable at any time to cause serious accidents to the passerby, an emergency is therefore declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
