

Ordinance
No. 612

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon to enter into a contract with A. W. Rocksteader for the improvement of Second Street from the east curb line of Main Street to the west curb line of Harrison Street.

Whereas by ordinance No. 607 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the council on the 17th day of August, 1912, it was ordered that the following street in the City of Albany, to-wit: Second Street from the east curb line of Main Street to the west curb line of Harrison Street be improved in the following manner:

- First: By grading said street to the required sub-grade.
Second: By grading said street six inches deep in the center and three inches deep at the outer edges, twelve feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer then on file with the City Recorder of the City of Albany; and

Whereas, it was provided in said ordinance that the Recorder of the City of Albany give notice or bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance; and

Whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids made and given by the City Recorder of said city according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit: On the 5th day of September, 1912 A. W. Rocksteader presented to the Council of said city his bid for making said improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions imposed by law and the council, by which said bid said A. W. Rocksteader proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the sum of \$638.00.

And, Whereas, said A. W. Rocksteader was the lowest bidder for said proposed work and said bid was the lowest and best therefor,

The People of the City of Albany do hereby as follows:

Section 1. That the said bid of the said A. W. Rocksteader for said improvement of said described street be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said city are hereby authorized to enter into a contract in conformity with the said A. W. Rocksteader on the making of said improvement as aforesaid in behalf of the City of Albany, Oregon, upon the terms mentioned

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in said bid and the agreement hereinafter mentioned.

Said contract to provide further that work of said improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract and be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of October, 1912, and the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the work is delayed, beyond said specified time, and that said C. W. Hockstader furnish bond in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the said C. W. Hockstader and further indemnify the City of Albany against any claims or liens for labor, work or materials on the part of any person arising out of such contract.
