An Ordinance fixing the salary of the night policeman of the City of Albany, Oregon, and repealing all ordinance and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:-

Section 1. The night policemen of the City of Albany shall receive from and after January 1st 1913 as full compensation for their services in the discharge of their duties as such officers, the sum of \$900.00 per annum.

Section 2. The salary of the above named officers shall be paid to them by warrant on the City treasurer monthly after the service has been rendered.

Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed in as far as the same are in conflict herewith.
