An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 378 of the City of Albany, Oregon passed by the council notwithstanding the disapproval of the Mayor March 28, 1913.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 378 of the City of Albany, Oregon, passed by the council notwithstanding the disapproval of the Mayor March 28, 1913, is and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The Recorder of the City of Albany shall receive as full compensation for his services, both as recorder and as Clerk of the Council, an annual sum of \$1200.00, payable monthly out of the general fund of said city by warrants drawn upon the Treasurer.

Section 2. Wherein this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
