

Ord No 641

An ordinance creating the office of building inspector and defining his powers and duties.

The People of the City of Albany Do Enact as Follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created the office of building inspector, who shall have the power in all cases where a building is being erected or remodeled to enter such building and examine the work and materials and shall have the power to stop any or all work not complying with the requirements of Ordinance No 633 of the City of Albany and shall give notice in writing to the owner of such building, contractor or superintendent of fact with copies with the provisions of said ordinance.

Whenever complaint is made in writing to the building inspector of the violation of any of the provisions of said ordinance or he shall know or have reasonable grounds to believe that any of the provisions of said ordinance are being violated by any person or persons, he is hereby empowered to enter upon the premises or place or go into any building, about which complaint is made or upon or in which he may have reasonable grounds to believe that any of the provisions of said ordinance are being violated and should the building inspector upon such examination find said ordinance being violated or should any owner, contractor or superintendent upon whom notice has been served as above provided, fail to conform to said ordinance, the said building inspector shall caused to be filed a complaint in the Recorder's Court against such person or persons for such violation.

Section 2. The building inspector shall be elected by the council and serve during their pleasure.
