An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 63, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the running of railroad cars, railroad trains and locomotives, and to prohibit persons, other than employees from climbing upon, boarding or entering said railroad cars at any place other than the regular depot", passed the council November 12, 1888, approved November 14, 1888.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 63, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the running of railroad cars, railroad trains and locomotives, and to prohibit persons, other than employees, from climbing upon, boarding or entering said railroad cars at any place other than the regular depot", passed the council November 12, 1888, approved November 14, 1888, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons running, conducting or managing a locomotive, railroad train, electric car or street car to run the said locomotive, or railroad train or electric car or street car on any railroad track or street car track within the corporate limits of the City of Albany at a greater rate of speed than twelve (12) miles per hour.
