

ORDINANCE NO. 660.

Ord No 660

An ordinance to repeal Ordinance No. 601, entitled "An ordinance requiring all railroad companies and all street car companies within the City of Albany, Oregon, to place, install and maintain certain electric lights within the City of Albany and providing a penalty for violation hereof," passed the council July 24th, 1912, and approved by the Mayor July 25th, 1912.

The People of the City of Albany shall have as follows:

Section 1.
