

ORDINANCE NO. 664

Baptist, Albany, Oregon

Ord 664

An ordinance declaring it unlawful for any person
Rep 1506 to carry or haul any intoxicating liquor through the streets,
alleys or other public place in the City of Albany, except the packages
in which such intoxicating liquors are shipped into the City of Albany
and providing a penalty therefor.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. Any person or persons who shall carry or haul
through any street, alley, avenue or other public place within the City
of Albany any intoxicating liquors of any kind except the packages in
which such intoxicating liquors are shipped into the City of Albany
shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. Whenever any peace officer of the City of Albany
or the County of Lincoln has reasonable grounds to believe that any
person or persons are carrying any intoxicating liquors within the
City of Albany other than said packages in which such intoxicating
liquors are shipped into the City of Albany, said peace officer shall
have power to search said persons or persons or the things carried by
said person or persons or the conveyance used by said person or persons
and in case intoxicating liquors are found being carried or hauled in
violation of Section 1 of this ordinance, the said intoxicating liquors
together with such person violating Section 1 of this ordinance
shall be taken before the Recorder of the City of Albany and a com-
plaint filed against such person by said officer.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of
this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's
Court be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$150.00 or be
imprisoned in the city jail not less than five nor more than fifty
days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of
the court and said court in case of conviction shall order
publicly destroyed any and all intoxicating liquors found
carried or hauled in violation of this ordinance.

Section 4. Whereas this ordinance is necessary
for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby
declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force from and
after its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
