

Ord 702

An ordinance selecting and providing for purchase of a site upon which to erect a city hall and providing for the amount of a part thereof and the amount in which title shall be acquired.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the lot and site property to and the same is hereby accepted as a site upon which to erect and maintain a city hall as authorized by the charter of the City of Albany.

Section 2. Twenty-nine (29) in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 3. That there shall be paid out of the said premises, and the same arising from the sale of bonds thereto, the sum of \$22,000.00.

Section 4. That the provisions herein be not in any way conditional upon the acceptance of the terms hereof by the present owner or owners of the premises, and their acceptance shall be in writing by the owner or owners of said premises and together with an abstract shall be filed with the recorder of the City of Albany within 10 days after the approval of this ordinance.

Section 5. That in case of the failure of said acceptance of the terms herein by the owner or owners of said premises as herein provided, and the expiration of the time by said owner or owners to execute the abstract thereto, the city attorney shall within 10 days thereafter examine the abstract of title and make report thereon to the city council concerning the conditions of the title to the property as hereon provided, and the city attorney shall file a report thereon to the council at the time and place as herein provided.

Section 6. That at any time after the city attorney has filed a report to the council concerning the conditions of the title to the property as herein provided, and upon the order of the council and subject to the approval of the council, the city attorney shall cause a warrant to be issued for the sum of \$22,000.00, and the money thereon shall be used for the same purpose as the money on the bonds in the amount of \$22,000.00, and the money thereon shall be used for the same purpose as the money on the bonds in the amount of \$22,000.00.

Section 6. If no existing conditions are such that the ordinance is necessary with immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, or emergency, it shall be subject to the usual procedure of the council and approval of the people.
