Ordinance to amend Section 20 of Ordinance 1506  
The City of Chicago, Illinois, do hereby amend the ordinance  
concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, which was  
enacted by the Board of the Council March 3, 1887,  
and amended by the Mayor May 13, 1887,

The People of the City of Chicago, Illinois, do hereby amend the

Section 10 of Ordinance No. 1506, which is  
an Ordinance concerning disorderly conduct, and  
fixing what shall constitute the same and prescribing the  
punishment therefor, passed by the Council March 3, 1887, in  
substitution of the Ordinance passed by the Council May 13, 1887,  
as follows:

Section 10. Any person or persons who shall within  
the corporate limits of the City of Chicago, trespass upon or  
wantonly or maliciously damage any real or personal  
property, the same being in the City of Chicago by any public or  
private corporation, or any individual or individuals, or  
who shall insult any person upon any street, sidewalk, or  
park or in any public or private place in the City of Chicago,  
or who shall use any obscene language upon a telephone, or  
abusive or obscene language upon a radio, or who shall  
for the purpose of insulting any person, or shall be imprisoned in  
the City Jail, or shall be fined more than ten dollars, or  
more than one hundred dollars, or shall be imprisoned in  
a cell, at the discretion of the court.
