

SAVING ALBANY, OREGON

Albany

an ordinance making it unlawful to permit card playing, dice throwing or other games of chance in any public place in the City of Albany and making it unlawful for any person to buy, carry, trade, sell or other game of chance in a public place in the City of Albany, providing what shall be deemed playing cards and providing a penalty or violation thereon.

The People of the City of Albany Ordain as follows:

Section 1. If any person owns the corner, lease, proprietorship, employment or any other public business room in this city or town, with the name establishment or any public place within the City of Albany shall sell, or permit any person or persons to maintain any game of cards, throwing of dice, raffling or other game of chance, of any kind or nature in any public place, public billiard room, public pool room, or other establishment or any public place situated for amusement or otherwise, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by the Recorder's Court with a fine of not less than one nor more than five dollars or imprisonment not more than thirty days or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 2. Any person who shall engage in any game of cards, dice throwing, raffling or other game of chance in any public place within the City of Albany shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by the Recorder's Court with a fine of not less than five dollars or imprisonment not more than thirty days or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. For the purpose of this ordinance, the production of a deck of cards or a portion of a deck of cards by any person within a public place, which deck or portion of a deck is not in the original package, shall be deemed evidence sufficient to sustain a conviction for having cards or a permitting card playing in a public place.
