

Ord No 748

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Ferry Street from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street, providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvement, if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement of said part of said street, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for bids for the completion of such improvement of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Ferry Street from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street full width with full intersections with Asphaltic Concrete pavement.
- Third: By laying <sup>and</sup> constructing asphaltic concrete sidewalks.
- Fourth: By constructing catch basins.
- Fifth: By constructing inlets.
- Sixth: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon and the plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of Ferry Street, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 10th day of August, 1915, and endorsed "Engineer's plans and specifications for the improvement of Ferry Street from the South line of Ninth Street to the North line of Twelfth Street and the estimates of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost thereof."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of said Ferry Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising from and out of the assessments hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the council of said city of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Ferry Street to be so improved, and especially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the laws of said city.

The said improvement of said portion of said Ferry Street shall be completed by the 1st day of November, 1914.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract or contracts are made by the City in the making of said improvement shall before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient sureties in the sum of Two thousand Five hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Ferry Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damage on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice to each for the making of said improvement of said portion of Ferry Street, by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Herald, a daily news paper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Ferry Street.
