

and construct a lateral sewer for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer beginning at the main sewer in Baker Street and running westerly through the center of Block Four, Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, across Lyon Street and through the center of Block 19 in the City of Albany, Oregon, providing however the cost of such improvement shall be paid by the person or persons making such improvement if the same be not completed within the time agreed upon and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement and paying for the same by the Recorder of said City of Albany if proper notice for such purpose be given of such improvement.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed a terra cotta sewer beginning at the main sewer in Baker Street and running westerly through the center of Block Four, Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, across Lyon Street and through the center of Block 19 in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Said improvement is to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said city for the construction of said sewer filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 14th day of October, 1874.

The cost of said lateral sewer from the main sewer in Baker Street to the west line of said street and across Lyon Street shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the general funds of said city; the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising out of the assessments to be made, ascertained and declared by ordinance on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said improvement, and to be made and especially and particularly levied thereby as provided in the Charter of said city.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of January, 1875. All bills for the making of said improvement deemed reasonable by the council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Whoever enters or cooperation with anyone any contract made or intended to be made for the making of said improvement shall before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing of such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city, a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, in the sum of three hundred dollars, to the effect that the contractor shall

contract.

Section 2. The firm, person or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make and improve... not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contracts, and such amount shall be paid by such contractor to the city upon the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give public notice by publishing in the Albany Daily Democrat, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, full description in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
