

And to license, providing, on the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer between Front and Water Streets and running westerly across Oak Street, through the center of Block 2, across Sherman Street, through the center of Block 2, to within 10 feet of the east line of Main Street, all in Huchelman's Third Ordinance to the City of Albany, Oregon, said line has the cost of such improvements and to provide, the person or persons making such improvements, if the same be not completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond to the satisfaction of the work, and the improvement, and providing on the given by the Recorder of said City of Albany of proper notice for bids for the completion of said improvements.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer beginning at the manhole in the Oak Street trunk sewer, between Front and Water Streets, and running westerly across Oak Street, through the center of Block 2, across Sherman Street, through the center of Block 2, to within 10 feet of the east line of Main Street, all in Huchelman's Third Ordinance to the City of Albany, Oregon.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said city for the construction of said lateral sewer filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 5th day of April, 1914.

The cost of said lateral sewer shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising out of assessments to be made, ascertained and declared by ordinance on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said improvements to be made and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said City.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of April, 1915.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation which enters any contract may be entered into by the city for the making of said improvement shall before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said city, a good and sufficient bond with surety and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany in the sum of \$2000 for the faithful performance of

contract.

Section 2. If the firm, person or corporation as herein to contract with the said City, behaves to make said improvements and not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the terms of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Democrat, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
