

An Ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a stone sewer running at the manhole in Oak Street, sever between U. Street First & Second, in the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westward across Oak Street and through the center of Block 8½, Hacken, and Third Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and to within one-half of the east line of Sherman Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 2½ feet, providing for the cost of said improvement to be paid, the payment to be made to the City of Albany by the persons making such improvement, to the sum of \$100, or less, at cost, within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving to the Recorder, said City of Albany, of proper notice for bids for the construction of said improvement.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed an eight-inch  
valley fire terra cotta sewer, 4½ inches at the manholes, 6 inches  
diameter, sever between U. Street and First Street in the City of Albany,  
Oregon, and running thence westward across Oak Street and through  
the center of Block 8½, Hacken, and Third Addition to the City of  
Albany, Oregon, to within one-half of the east line of Sherman  
Street, in the City of Albany, Oregon, a distance of 2½ feet.

That all contracts shall be made in accordance with  
the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and payment  
and acceptance is to be made to the City Engineer of, and the  
construction of, said sewer, supervised by the engineer, the work  
of the City of Albany, Oregon, \$100.

That no bid, and bidders, sever shall do it, shall be, to  
make contracts, as a result, so it is the agreement, to take work  
ascertained as follows, and distance as the same may be, to  
be performed to and in the contract, to be made and executed  
and particular as the City Engineer, or, held by the contractor,  
etc.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of  
August 10.

Bids for the making of said improvement deemed  
unreasonable by the City of Albany being rejected.

And whereas, same incorporation with the city, and certain  
habits have been maintained, it is the intent of the city to make him,

promised and agreed to and deliver to said city a good and sufficient and timely and sufficient surety to be approved by the Mayor of the City, in the sum of \$100.00 for the faithful performance of said contract.

Action 2. No person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the City of Astoria to make said improvement shall not commence the same before the time mentioned and specified in said contract, and citizens are entitled to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid to a contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Action 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby directed to immediately give written notice for bids for the making of said improvement by publishing such notice ten days in the Astoria Daily Democrat a daily newspaper published in said City, or by any fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
