

Ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of certain improvement which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined in Resolution No. 15, adopted by said Council on the 1st day of April, 1915, to make on Second Street from the east line of Lyon Street to the west curb line of Main Street; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportions to share, and the probable cost of such improvement of said Second Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Second Street to be improved; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the Pocket of said City as provided by the charter of said City.

Whereas, on the 24th day of March, 1915, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make amended plans and specifications for the improvement of Second Street from the east line of Lyon Street to the west curb line of Main Street in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street with asphalt at all intersections with asphaltic concrete pavement and asphaltic concrete foundations.
- Third: By laying and constructing asphaltic concrete pavement.
- Fourth: By constructing concrete combination curb and walks.
- Fifth: By constructing catch basins.
- Sixth: By constructing inlets.
- Seventh: By laying vitrified sewer pipe.
- Eighth: By laying sub-drain tile.

and for estimates of the work to be done on the said portion of Second Street and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such amended plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's Office of said City, said resolution being numbered Resolution No. 15 and adopted the 24th day of March, 1915, and

Whereas, the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 15 made amended plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution for the improvement of said Second Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 15 and filed said amended plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office in said City on the 1st day of April, 1915, and

Whereas, the said Council on the 1st day of April, 1915, by Resolution No. 15, duly adopted by said Council determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council agreed to improve Second Street from the East line of Lyon Street to the west curb line of Main Street in the manner specified in said Resolution

That

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 15 adopted as aforesaid by the Council, the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said order and improvement of said Second Street from the east line of 4th Street to the west end line of Main Street as provided by the Charter of said City; and

Whereas, the Recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the Council of said City, Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Second Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

Whereas, the said Council, in and by said Resolution No. 15 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Second Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said Second Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 15 to be the sum of \$11,922.75

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Second Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the east line of 4th Street to the west end line of Main Street, shall be improved as follows:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street, full width with asphaltic concrete or asphaltic concrete pavement on an asphaltic concrete foundation.
- Third: By staining and curbing asphaltic concrete curbs.
- Fourth: By constructing concrete curbs, sidewalks and curbs.
- Fifth: By constructing catch basins.
- Sixth: By constructing manholes.
- Seventh: By installing and setting sewer pipes.
- Eighth: By installing catch basins.

All in accordance with said Resolution No. 15 and the amended plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City, Albany on the 14th day of April, 1915.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said

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improvements, said Second Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, from the east line of said street to the west curb line of Main Street in the manner heretofore determined by the council of the said City of Albany in and by said Resolution (1015) with Assessor's Excise Taxment to be paid by the owners of the real property abutting to said portion of Second Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$17,932.75.

Article 2.

That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Second Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of Second Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined hereinafter in and by said Resolution (1015) is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set out and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof as follows:

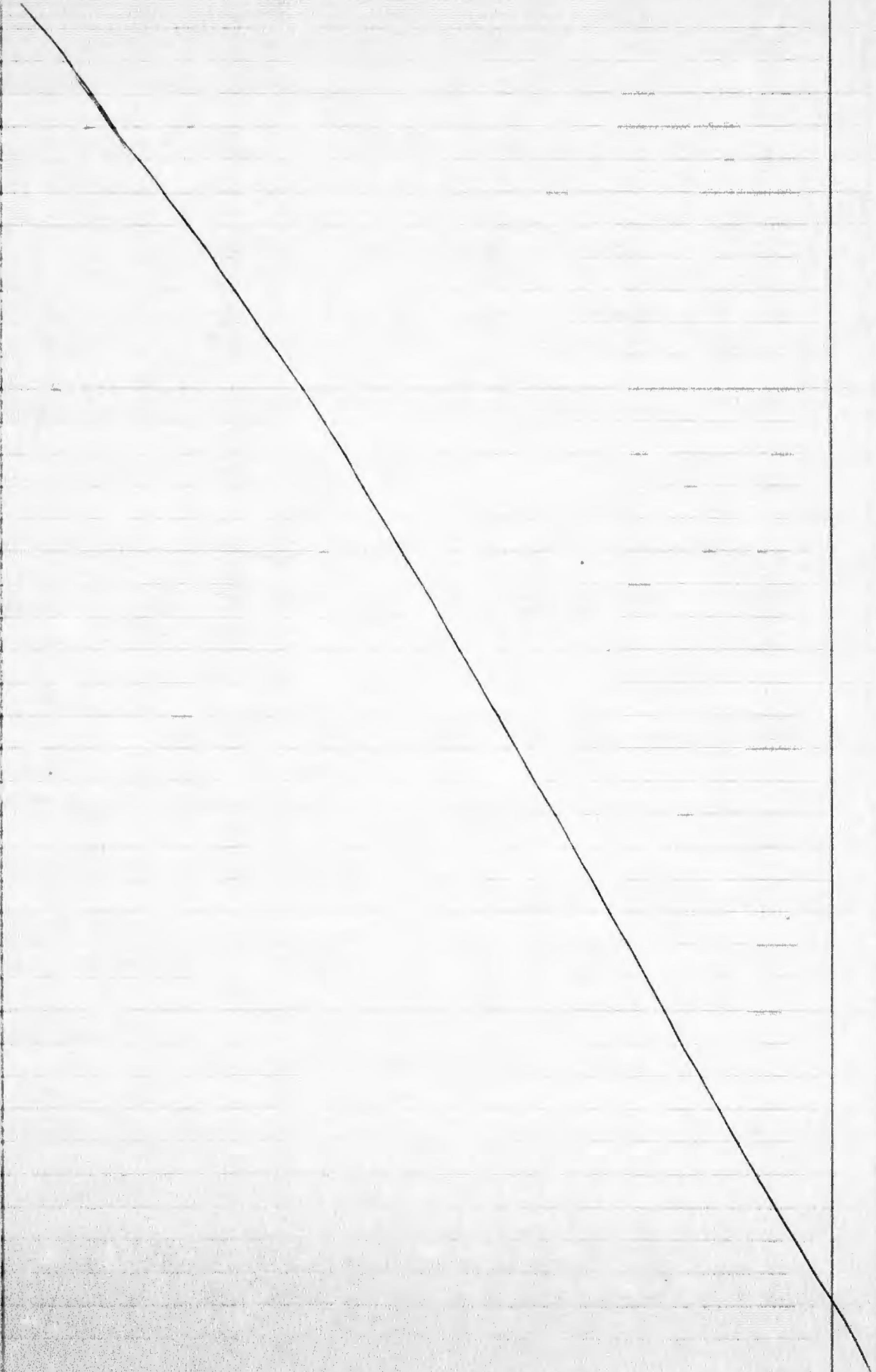
