

ORDINANCE NO. 841

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING A CERTAIN TYPE OF FENDER TO BE USED ON STREET CARS, ELECTRIC CARS AND ELECTRIC RAILROADS OPERATING WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That from and after the date when this ordinance becomes effective any person, firm, corporation or joint stock company, owning or operating any street cars, electric cars or electric railroads within the corporate limits of the city of Albany, Oregon, shall be permitted to use on said street cars, electric cars or electric railroads a type of fender known as the Eclipse Fender.

Section 2. That it is for the best interests of the residents and inhabitants of the City of Albany that fenders of the type known as the Eclipse Fender be permitted to be used for the reason that such type of fenders operate automatically in emergencies requiring its use and thus enables motormen to give their first attention to shutting off the power and applying the brakes on the cars which they are operating.
