

ORDINANCE NO. 914

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, UPON THE ASSESSMENT MADE IN 1917, SAID TAX TO BE COLLECTED IN 1918.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a tax levy for the City of Albany, Oregon upon the assessment made in 1917, for taxes to be collected in 1918, be and the same is hereby made as follows:

General running expenses	\$26,700.00
Interest on bond indebtedness	1,200.00
Sinking fund \$75,000.00 refunding bonds	1,700.00
" " \$22,000.00 City Hall Site bonds	1,100.00
" " \$19,000.00 Sewer bonds	1,267.00
" " \$ 8,000.00 " "	534.00
Library Fund	1,897.00
Interest of bond sinking fund for outstanding warrants and proposed bond issues	10,032.00
Total	\$49,490.00.

to be levied upon the equal assessment valuation of all assessable property, both real and personal, in said City of Albany, as shown and appears upon the assessment roll of Linn County made in the year 1917 with a valuation amounting to \$3,283,565, exclusive of property owned by public utilities to be assessed by the State Tax Commission and which has not yet been reported.

Section 2. The recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately notify the County Clerk and County Assessor of the County of Linn of this levy in writing and under the seal of said City.
