

## ORDINANCE No. 919

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ANY ALIEN CHINESE PERSON OR PERSONS, FROM EMPLOYING, HIRING OR HARBORING WHITE FEMALE PERSONS IN STORES, HOUSES, SHOPS, RESTAURANTS, LAUNDRIES OR OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS OWNED OR OPERATED BY SUCH CHINESE WITHIN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND PRESCRIBING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any alien Chinese person or persons who may be the owner or manager or in control of any store, shop, house, restaurant, laundry or other establishment or enterprise within the City of Albany, Oregon, to employ, hire or harbor in or about such premises any white female person or persons either as partner, lessee, lessor, employee or in any other capacity whatsoever.

Section 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$50.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not less than five nor more than twenty-five days or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
