ORDINANCE NO. 1052

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE repealing an ordinance entitled "An Ordinance to prohibit any Alien Chinese person or persons, from employing, hiring or harboring white female persons in stores, houses, shops, restaurants, laundries or other establishments owned or operated by such Chinese within the City of Albany, Oregon, and prescribing a penalty for violation thereof.", passed by the Council on February 13th. 1918 and approved by the Mayor on February 13th. 1918.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Ordinance No. 919 entitled "An Ordinance to prohibit any Alien Chinese person or persons from employing, hiring, or harboring white female persons in stores, houses, shops, restaurants, laundries or other establishments owned or operated by such Chinese within the City of Albany, Oregon, and prescribing a penalty for violation thereof." be and the same is hereby repealed.
