

ORDINANCE NO. 1072

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE To amend Section 8 of Ordinance No. 141 entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses", passed by the council February 9th, 1866, and approved by the mayor, February 10th, 1866 and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 141 of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, entitled "An ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain callings, trades and employments and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses" be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8. The proprietor or agent of all other exhibitions, entertainments or shows traveling from place to place and exhibiting for money not enumerated in this ordinance shall pay a license in the sum of \$100.00 per week, for a daily license of the sum of \$25.00.
