

ORDINANCE NO. 1207.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to enter a credit in the docket of City Liens against certain assessments heretofore made for the improvement of Second Street, from the West line of Cleveland Street to the West line of Geary Street in the full amount of such assessments.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany has heretofore proceeded to improve and has improved Second Street from the West line of Cleveland Street to the West line of Geary Street in said City by grading and graveling the same in accordance with the plans and specifications for such improvement filed in the office of the Recorder on the 11th day of March, 1925; and, by Ordinance No. 1185 has levied an assessment upon each lot, or part thereof, adjacent to such improvement in the manner provided by law for the making of such improvement, said assessment having been duly docketed in the Docket of City Liens of said City; and

WHEREAS, before the making of said improvement the several owners of the real property adjacent to the south side of said portion of said Street, conveyed to the City of Albany, by proper conveyances, a portion of their respective lots and parts of lots adjacent to such improvement, for the purpose of widening said Street, said several conveyances having been heretofore accepted by said City, and said conveyances having been made for the consideration that said property on the south side of said portion of said street should be relieved by the City of Albany of all charges and liens created by reason of the making of such improvement.

THEREFORE,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby authorized and directed to enter in the docket of City Liens in the proper column thereof a credit for the full amount of the assessments heretofore made for the improvement of Second Street from the West line of Cleveland Street to the West line of Geary Street in said City, and in favor of the following named persons, to-wit:

Joseph Hume.-- Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 in Block 1 in Dubruille & Ketchum's Addition.
J.O.Brown.--Lots 3 and 4 in Block 1, in Dubruille & Ketchum's Addition.
J.O.Brown and Rnda Brown.--Lot 2 in Block 1 in Dubruille & Ketchum's Addition.
Sarah A. Adkins.-- Lot 1 in Block 1 in Dubruille & Ketchum's Addition.
Wm. H. Kirk.--Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, and the East 12.54 feet of Lot 7 in Block 1 in Schmeer's Addition.
V.O.Wait.--Lots 9 and 10 and the East 10 feet of Lot 11 in Block 1 in Schmeer's Addition.
City of Albany, Oregon.--Lot 8 and the West 13.73 feet of Lot 7 in Block 1 in Schmeer's Addition.


