

ORDINANCE No. 1295

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$5707.50 of the general fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, in payment of the purchase price of one LaFrance 500 gallon triple combination pumper, and to authorize the Recorder of said City to execute and deliver to the Howard-Cooper Corporation the general fund warrant of the City of Albany for said purpose.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$5707.50 in payment of the purchase price of one LaFrance 500 gallon triple combination pumper for the use of the fire department of said city.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the Howard-Cooper Corporation the general fund warrant of the City of Albany in the sum and for the purpose mentioned in Section 1 of this ordinance.


