

ORDINANCE NO. 1308

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer, which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 6, adopted on the 13th day of February, 1929, beginning on the Cottage Street trunk sewer on Albany-Corvallis Road, in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the southeast corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly 834 feet through the center of blocks 3 and 4 of said Albany Heights Addition to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition, by laying an 8" sewer pipe; to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement that is assessed upon the lots or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land, adjacent to said improvement; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of said assessment in the docket of city liens, as provided by the charter of said City.

WHEREAS, on the 26th day of December, 1928, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution, No. 33, requiring Charles H. Leonard, engineer, to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sewer, beginning on the Cottage Street trunk sewer on Albany-Corvallis Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the southeast corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly 834 feet through the center of blocks 3 and 4 of said Albany Heights Addition to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition, and estimates of probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 23rd day of January, 1929, and

WHEREAS, said engineer pursuant to Resolution No. 33, made plans, specifications and estimates, as directed, for the construction of said lateral sewer, and filed the same with the Recorder as aforesaid, on the 23rd day of January, 1929, and

WHEREAS, the Council on the 13th day of February, 1929, by Resolution No. 6, duly adopted by the Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient, and said Council proposed to construct said lateral sewer, as hereinabove directed, and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said resolution No. 6 gave due notice of said improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said city, and on the 27th day of March, 1929, pursuant to said notice Fred H. Slate submitted his bid to the Council for the making of said improvement for the sum of \$1104.40, which said bid was received and accepted in and by Ordinance No. 1307, passed by the Council on the 27th day of March, 1929, and approved by the Mayor on the 27th day of March, 1929.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an 8" vitrified terra cotta sewer shall be constructed, beginning on the Cottage Street trunk sewer on Albany-Corvallis Road in the City of Albany, Oregon, 16 feet southerly from the southeast corner of lot 1 in block 3 in Albany Heights Addition to Albany, Oregon, and running thence northerly 834 feet through the center of blocks 3 and 4 of said Albany Heights Addition to the northeast corner of lot 7 in block 4 in said Addition, in accordance with Resolution No. 6, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 23rd day of January, 1929.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making such improvement in the manner hereinabove determined by the Council of said City, by Resolution No. 6, and by the bid of said Fred H. Slate, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$1,237.17, and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of the property adjacent thereto, and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of \$1,086.81.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, or parcel or tract of land adjacent thereto, as assessed and determined by the Council, is hereby determined and ascertained to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of said lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land, as follows, to-wit:
