

ORDINANCE NO. 1324

AN ORDINANCE regulating the traffic of motor vehicles within the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing a penalty for violation thereof.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park and leave standing and unattended any motor vehicle upon the school building side of any public street within any city block in the City of Albany, Oregon, upon which block a public school building is situated; provided that this section shall not apply to such days when the schools in such buildings are not in session; provided further that this section shall not apply to school buses, nor to vehicles while loading or unloading passengers.

Section 2. Any person violating section 1 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Recorder's Court of the City of Albany, Oregon, be fined in a sum not less than One Dollar (\$1.00), nor more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00), or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not less than one nor more than five days.
