

## ORDINANCE NO. 1397

AN ORDINANCE providing for the holding of a special election in the City of Albany, Oregon, on January 31, 1938, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said City for their adoption or rejection, an amendment to the Charter of said City providing for the adoption of a system of civil service for its full time paid fire fighters.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That for the purposes set forth herein and in the manner provided by law and this ordinance, a special election is hereby called to be held in the City of Albany, Oregon, on January 31, 1938, commencing at the hour of eight o'clock A.M. and continuing until the hour of eight o'clock P.M. of said day.

Section 2. Said special election shall be held and conducted at the same time and in the same manner as the general special election held throughout the State of Oregon on said day and the polling places for the holding of said special election within said City are hereby designated as those places in said City where said general special election will be held and that the judges and clerks of the special election hereby called shall be the same judges and clerks as those for the general special election within said City.

Section 3. That the recorder of the City of Albany shall give notice of said special election by publication thereof in the Albany Democrat Herald, a newspaper of general circulation published within the City of Albany, Oregon, once a week for two successive and consecutive weeks within thirty days next preceding such election and in the manner as provided by the Charter of said City.

Section 4. That at said special election a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be submitted to the legal voters of said City for their adoption or rejection, which said proposed amendment shall be known and designated as Sub-division 72 of Section 76 of Article IV of said Charter and shall be in words and figures as follows, to-wit: "The Common Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall have power to adopt a system of civil service for its full time paid fire fighters and make all the necessary provisions therefor"

Section 5. That the ballot title and ballot form for such amendment shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS  
BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY  
OF ALBANY, OREGON.

An act to amend Section 76 of Article IV of the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon, by adding another sub-division thereto to be designated as sub-division 72, to provide for the adoption of a system of civil service for the full time fire fighters of said City.

Shall the above be adopted? Vote Yes or no.

Section 6. The Recorder shall cause to be printed in pamphlet form a true copy of the ballot title and text of such proposed amendment with the number and form in which the same will be printed on the official ballot and shall mail a copy thereof to each voter in the City of Albany, Oregon, whose address he may have, not later than five days before the date of such special election and in the manner as provided by law.

Section 7. That the Recorder of said City shall cause to be printed and shall supply a sufficient number of ballots and other necessary and proper supplies for such election.
