

ORDINANCE NO. 1403.

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, to purchase of Halston Motor Company one 1936 Dodge chassis with cab and equipment for Fire department use and appropriating the sum of \$670.00 in payment thereof and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Albany is hereby authorized to purchase of Halston Motor Company one 1936 Dodge Chassis with cab and equipment for Fire Department use at and for the sum of \$670.00.

Section 2. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the general fund of said City the sum of \$670.00 in payment of the purchase price of one 1936 Dodge chassis referred to in Section 1 hereof and when the invoice thereof shall have been properly presented to and allowed by the Council as a valid claim against the City of Albany the Recorder will then be authorized to make, execute and deliver to the said Halston Motor Company the general fund warrant of said City in the amount of said claim allowed, but not to exceed the amount hereby appropriated.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
