ORDINANCE NO. 1415.

An ORDINANCE to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1266 entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the organization of a Volunteer Fire Department of the City of Albany, to prescribe its duties, and to regulate the same." Passed by the Council December 23, 1927, and approved by the Mayor December 23, 1927.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1266, entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the organization of a Volunteer Fire Department of the City of Albany, to prescribe its duties, and to regulate the same." Passed by the Council December 23, 1927, and approved by the Mayor December 23, 1927, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The Volunteer Fire Department of the City of Albany shall be composed of citizens of Albany who volunteer their services to the city for the purpose of composing and formulating an organization for the prevention and extinguishment of fires; such organization shall have power to elect its own officers, pass and promulgate its own by-laws, providing at all times that no by-law or rule passed by such organization shall be in conflict with the charter and ordinances of the city of Albany."

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective; therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be and become in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
