

ORDINANCE NO. 1464

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$588.00 for the purpose of purchasing 500 feet of two and one-half inch hose for the Fire Department and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$588.00 for the purpose of purchasing 500 feet of two and one-half inch hose of U.S. Rubber Products, Inc., for the Fire Department of the City of Albany.

Section 2. That upon the delivery of said hose and the due acceptance thereof by the Committee of Fire and Water the Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the General Fund in favor of the U.S. Rubber Products, Inc., in the amount hereby appropriated.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this ordinance become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
