

ORDINANCE NO. 1521

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$358.00 of the General Funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, in payment of the amount due the Chemical Equipment Company of California for work, labor and materials furnished in the improvement of the Municipal Swimming Pool and authorizing the Recorder to issue and deliver a warrant in said amount.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$358.00, it being the amount due the Chemical Equipment Company of California for work, labor and materials furnished in the improvement of the Municipal Swimming Pool of said City and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to issue the General Fund Warrant of said City payable to the said Chemical Equipment Company of California in the amount hereby appropriated.


