

ORDINANCE NO. 1563

A BILL FOR

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$1652.27 of the General Funds of the City of Albany for the purpose of purchasing one, one and a half ton Dodge Truck and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the City of Albany the sum of \$1652.27 for the purpose of purchasing one one and a half ton Dodge Truck for City purposes.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby authorized and directed to issue the General Fund warrant payable to Ralston Motor Company when said truck shall have been fully accepted by the proper authorities of the City of Albany.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany require that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
