

ORDINANCE NO. 1664

A Bill for:

An Ordinance providing for the registration of bicycles within the City of Albany, Oregon.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Every person who owns and operates a bicycle within the City of Albany shall register the same in the office of the Police Department of said city in the manner as hereinafter provided. The Police Department shall provide blank applications to be signed by each applicant for the registration of bicycles, which applications shall state the name, age, and address of the owner and a complete description of each bicycle sought to be registered, and upon the filing of such application the Police Department shall furnish the registrant with a registration card describing the bicycle so registered and shall deliver to the registrant a numbered metallic license tag, which tag shall be securely attached to the bicycle so registered.

Section 2. All registrations of bicycles as herein provided shall continue as long as title of such bicycle shall remain in the name of the registrant. When sold or otherwise disposed of the registrant shall report such disposition to the Police Department and thereafter the new owner shall obtain registration in his own name. All applications shall be accompanied by a fee of \$0.25. to cover the costs of registration and tags.
