A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE providing for the time and manner of improving <u>Cleveland</u> <u>Street</u> from the north line of Second Street to the south line of Front Street, and <u>Second treet</u> from the east line of Fine Street to the west line of Gary Street, and <u>Harrison Street</u> from the north line of Second Street to the south line of First st. In the City of albany, Gregon providing how the cost of such improvement shall be paid, the panalty or damage to the City of albany by the person of persons making such improvement if the same shall not be completed on the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvement, and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said city of notice for bids for the completion of said improvement.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO OFDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That <u>Cleveland Street</u> from the north line of Second Street to the south line of Front Street and <u>Second Street</u> from the east line of Fine Street to the west line of Gerry Street and <u>Marrison Street</u> from the north line of Second Street to the south line of First Street, shall be improved in the following manager to with following manner: to-wit:

- By grading the said street to the proper grade.
  By installing concrete curbing, gutter, and sidewalks wherever necessary.
  By making all other proper installations to completely improve
- said street.
- 4. By paving the same with Oil mat surface.

Said improvement shall be made in accordance with the Charter and Ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of Walter W. Larsen, Engineer, for the improvement of said Street filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 10th day of April, 1946.

The cost of the making of said improvement shall be paid out of the funds to be collected and arising upon and out of the assessments hareafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the Gity of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said street so to be improved as hereinabove described and specially and particularly benefited thereby, as provided by the charter of said city of oldany.

Said improvement shall be completed by the 1st day of September 1946.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the Council may be rejected.

Any person, firm or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of albany for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing such contract, make execute and deliver to said city a good and sufficient bond with sufficient surety thereon to be approved by the Favor of the City of Albany in a sum equal to fifty percent of the amount to be paid unler such contract for the faithful performance thereof.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation and ring into any con-tract with the City of Albany to make said improvement chall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in such contract, the City of albany shall be deened to suffer damages on account thereof in the amount of [25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delay-d beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof unless the time of the completion of said im-provement be extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Facorder of the City of albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for raking of said improve-ment by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Democratherald, a news-raper of general directation published in the city of albany, full describing in said notice the time and manner of doing said work of improving said portion of said street.
