A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 1681 entitled "An Ordinance relating to Traffic and regulating use of public streets in the City of Albany, Oregon; Defining and Establishing Farking Meter Zones and Regulating and Controlling and Providing for Inspection of the TIME PARKING of Vehicles therein by the use of PARKING METERS: FRESCRIBING limitations of time for parking in PARKING METERS: And Providing for Enforcement of this Ordinance and Punishment for its Violation", and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLO .: S:

Section 1. That there shall be added to Section 2 of said Ordinance in which the following portions of streets are hereby setablished as PARKING LETER ZONES; by adding to the list of streets THIRD STREET from FERRY EAST to BROADALBIN STREET.

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
